**Industry, utility providers, governments, emergency services, the risk and disaster management community, and academia.**

# INDEPENDENT STUDY BY ANU TECH POLICY DESIGN CENTRE

- ANU TPDC will seek endorsement by Risk Expert Panel and Steering Group.
- ANU TPDC retains editorial discretion over final product.
